TRACK THE PELICAN HOPPER ON YOUR SMART PHONE!

Residents and tourists who use the Lauderdale-By-The-Sea Pelican Hopper community shuttle can now use their smart phone to track the shuttle's location.

The Town entered into an agreement with Fort Lauderdale's Sun Trolley to use its award-winning Tracker App to provide shuttle passengers with real-time information about its location so they can determine how long it will be before it gets to their stop.

The Tracker App can be downloaded free from the App or Google Play stores or by visiting www.suntrolley.com/sun-trolley-tracker. It is available for Apple and Android smart phones, tablets, laptops and other devices, as well as desktop computers.

Robyn Chiarelli, Executive Director of the Downtown Fort Lauderdale TMA, which manages the Sun Trolley, said the expansion of the app to include the Pelican Hopper will improve connections for Sun Trolley customers who also use the Hopper.

“The Pelican Hopper and Sun Trolley’s Galt Link intersect at the Galt Ocean Mile Reading Center and the Fort Lauderdale Beach Community Center and the two routes share a similar customer base,” Chiarelli said. “We’ve received customer requests for better connections between the two routes, and adding the Pelican Hopper to the Tracker App is a good first step in improving that connection.”

In addition to publicizing the information in newspapers and on its Web sites and government channel, the Town will distribute flyers to Pelican Hopper passengers.
