## **MILLING /PAVING SCHEDULE**

### **Lauderdale-By-The-Sea**

**Dear Resident,**

All County Paving will soon begin the milling and paving process in your community and we'd like to address a few points prior to commencement.

- **Prior to paving, we will be milling (grinding down) the asphalt of all roadways and this phase will be accomplished June 13<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup>. Work hours will typically be M-F from 8:00 am – 6:00 pm. If you do not intend to leave the house that day, your car may remain in the driveway and if you leave for work during those hours, you will likely not be affected by our milling & paving operations.**
- **Please DO NOT PARK IN THE ROADS on those days, but all roads will remain open to traffic during this process.**
- **Please re-schedule all vendors as needed (landscapers, pool and maid services, pest control...) and also avoid any large deliveries or moving accordingly.**
- **Milled roads are safe to drive on but are somewhat bumpy and may contain some loose gravel. Please drive slowly and with caution until roads have been paved.**
- **Please bear in mind that this process can become dusty.**

**All County will start the milling process in the North section of Town (Silver Shores Neighborhood) on Monday June 13<sup>th</sup>. The entire street will need to be completely milled before the paving can start. Once a street has been milled it is the intention of All County to pave the street the following work day. While milling can be done in the rain paving will be contingent on the weather.**

- **Please make alternate parking arrangements with friends and neighbors for when your section of road is to be paved if you feel you will be exiting and entering your driveway throughout the day. You can also feel free to discuss your parking concerns with our project manager in the morning or if heavy equipment is working in front of your house during a time you need to leave.**
- **Roadside parking will not be allowed at any point during milling or paving processes.**

- **During Paving Operations it is imperative that you follow these instructions to ensure a quality re surfacing Project**
- **Tack coat: this is a black liquid which glues the new asphalt to the underlying surfaces. It will be applied each day immediately prior to paving. It is spray applied and very sticky. Make sure not to step in it or drive through it. If you do, clean your shoes immediately and do NOT pull into your driveway.**
- **Once paved and rolled, the roads are OK to drive on and walk across provided that you don't wear (ANY HEELS or walk with your BARE FEET).**
- **Each section will be re-opened daily upon completion. Please remember NOT TO TURN WHEELS IN PLACE on new asphalt. Most marks caused by tires are minor and disappear in time, but it is important to remember that new asphalt remains somewhat soft for at least a couple of weeks, particularly in the summer.**
- **Some light raveling is normal and will occur during the asphalt curing process (up to 6 months). You may also note some light tire tracks in driveways after paving. This is NOT tar, but only dirt from the new road surface. It will disappear over time.**
- **All County Paving will not be responsible for damage to cars, driveways and newly paved surfaces caused by failure to comply with these necessary steps.**
